

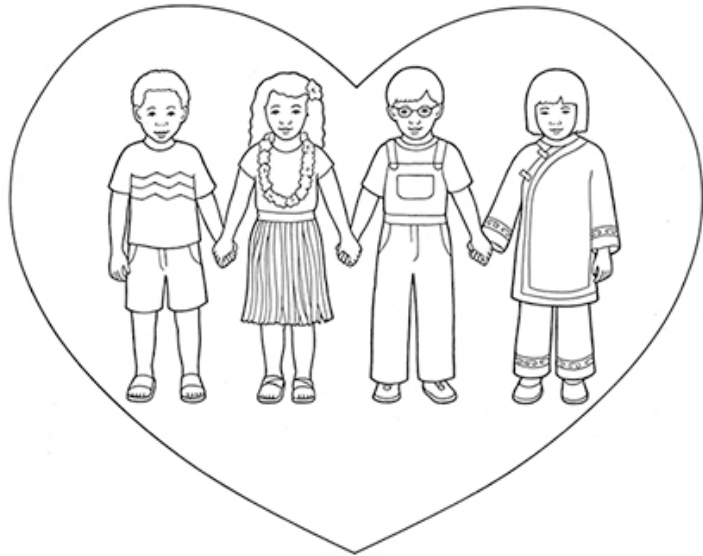
Jesus Loves Everyone

You can choose to love people by being nice to everyone.



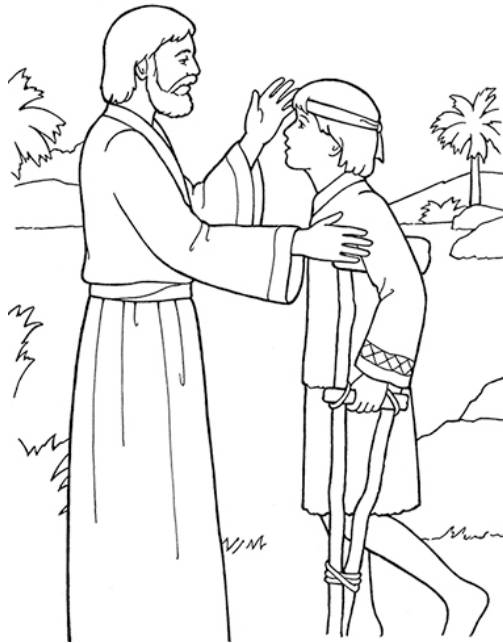
Jesus Visited the Sick

Jesus often visited people who were sick and healed them. One time, he healed a leper of his contagious skin disease because the leper had faith Jesus could heal him.

Matthew 8:2-3

"And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed."

You can visit people who are sick or hurt and help them feel better.



Jesus Forgave People

Jesus forgives a woman who committed adultery. Adultery is when a person does not keep their marriage promises. The Pharisees wanted to stone her as punishment, but Jesus forgave her and told her to not sin anymore.

John 8:3-11

"And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more."

You can choose to forgive people who have been mean to you by not staying angry at them.



Jesus Fed the Hungry

Jesus fed people who were hungry by giving them food. He sometimes did miracles to make food and drink appear so that people wouldn't be hungry. He fed 5,000 people with only 5 loaves of bread and 2 fishes.

Luke 9:12-17

"Then he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed them, and brake, and gave to the disciples to set before the multitude. And they did eat, and were all filled: and there was taken up of fragments that remained to them twelve baskets."

You can help feed hungry people by giving food to people who don't have any. You can also help by paying your tithing and fast offerings. (The money you give can buy food for hungry people.)



Jesus Calmed the Storms

Jesus calmed scary storms. One time he made a giant windstorm go away because his disciples were scared their ship would fall over into the water.

Mark 4:35-39

"And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.... And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm."

You can help people calm down by comforting them and being nice to them if they are scared or crying.



Jesus Blesses Children

Jesus loves children and blessed them. This means he said a prayer to Heavenly Father with the power of the priesthood. (The priesthood is the power of God.) God gives the priesthood to older boys and men so that they can bless their families and others.

Matthew 19:13-15

"Then were there brought unto him little children... Jesus said, suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven. And he laid his hands on them."

You can say prayers for friends and other children and ask Heavenly Father to bless them. Boys can be getting ready to have the priesthood by being righteous and obedient.



Jesus Said, "Come Follow Me"

Jesus asked Peter and Andrew to follow him and be his disciples. Right away they listened and followed Jesus. Jesus has also asked you to follow him.

Matthew 4:18-20

"And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men. And they straightway left their nets, and followed him."

You can listen to Jesus and follow him by obeying Him and wanting to be like Jesus. When you turn 8 you can be baptized.
